

Special Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
February 13, 2012

Present: Richard Carver, Nancy Colson and Linda Post, Selectmen

Richard Carver called the meeting to order at 4:10 P.M.

There was a brief discussion concerning the bids that were submitted for removing the dead trees in the Evergreen cemetery. After discussing the issue Richard made the motion to reject all the bids that were submitted and moved to ask the three lowest bidders to resubmit their bids and provide proof of insurance for the job. Nancy seconded the motion. Motion carried. The Selectmen will meet on Friday morning, February 17th at 9:00 A.M. to award the bid.

Richard informed the board that the harbor master returned the mooring applications that he removed from the town office. Along with the applications was a list of names who have a mooring in the harbor with no applications. Richard explained that according to town ordinance the town is required to have certain information regarding the moorings. The board discussed the possibility of writing a letter to the owners and also include a mooring application so the town can have current information.

The board discussed the fact that there are five keys to the sand and salt shed. Nancy informed the board that Frank Ross authorized Bruce Colson to have the keys made. Bruce has asked the question who he is supposed to report to when he removes sand and salt from the shed. The members of the board questioned why Bruce has a key to the shed. Nancy said that Bruce would not have a problem returning the key and only remove sand and salt when the town office is opened.

No other business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 4:40 P.M.
