Ash Point Drive (Map 9, Lot 7) Nancy Colson made a motion to accept an offer from Ernie Dugan of \$35,000, Linda Post seconded all in favor. All in Favor.

Mowing Bids have become an issue. Richard Carver talked to Farely & Sons and Marc Deane. Linda Post suggested that maybe next years bid should be for 3 years.

Frank Ross and Richard went to the FEMA meeting for the storm damage. Richard Carver is collecting all the rest of the paperwork needed. We also need photos of the town float that was damaged.
