

## SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

June 4, 2012

Present: Richard Carver, Nancy Colson, Linda Post, Dave Mathews

5:00 PM Meeting called to order

5:00 PM Tom Edwards was not present

5:05 PM Tom Christie (The Mussel Ridge Society) Every year the Mussel Ridge Society holds a craft fair at the Owls Head Community Building for a fund raiser. This year the fair has gotten big and they are going to move it to the Transportation Museum. They would like to borrow some of our tables for the crafters. Dick Carver made a motion that they can borrow some but they need to make sure the Community Building has not been rented or that the person renting does not need all the tables. Linda Post seconded it. Motion carried.

5:50 PM The sand and salt bids came in. Nancy made a motion to accept International for the salt and JBI for the sand. Richard Carver seconded it. Motion carried.

6:00 PM The selectmen would like to meet with Scott Bickford at the next Selectmen's meeting (June 18<sup>th</sup>) in regards to Ocean Avenue and an easement possibility. Also to talk about a walking path on Harborside Terrace.

6:30 PM Public Hearing for Ash Point Properties. 5 people were in attendance. Linda Post made a motion to accept the Liquor License and Nancy Colson seconded it. Motion carried.
