Tom Edwards is getting ready to send letter to the town people in regards to the new taxes coming out. He needs to put a mill rate on the calculation in the letter. He also wants the selectmen's input as to what to write in the letter. He will leave a base letter on the desk for them to look at and make changes. This letter will go out the 1st of August before the annual Town Meeting. The selectmen made a suggestion of 10.0 mil rate to put on the letter. He will enter that mil rate and leave the report tomorrow afternoon for the selectmen to look at.

Tom Edwards will be at Tax School on August 5th and August 6th then to Hancock on August 7th to commit their taxes. He will be available from August 9th to August 21st to talk to people if they have questions on their taxes. The dates will be in the letter.

Nancy Curtis and Carolyn Philbrook have concerns in regards to the speed limit on Ash Point Drive after the Dublin Road. Nancy Curtis will call William Leppenan and Richard Carver will call DOT to see if we can get this looked at.

Carolyn Philbrook also asked that the Bike lane on Ash Point Drive be repainted.

Warrant Article board - moratorium on wharfs, floats, docks. The selectmen have decided not to put a moratorium on it. There is going to be a new ordinance committee formed to work with the planning board in the future so they will leave it up to them to make an ordinance if they feel one should be done.

It was mentioned that MMA will be coming back July 23, 2013 to finish its examination of Town property.

On July 19, 2013 the Department of Labor meet with Richard Carver and did a walk through of the Fire Station. Everything went well.
