5:20 P.M. Bruce Colson & Frank Ross wanted to know why the \$1500.00 for recruiting was removed from the Budget. Ken Crane from the budget committee was there. They wanted more detail from the fire department as to how they were going use the money. Bruce Colson said it would go Advertising, like a banner, flyers, newspaper ads and TV ads. Richard Carver suggested they go to the planning board because we have no ordinances for dangerous buildings.

6:00 P.M. Laurie Pierce who works for Community School in Camden approached the selectmen along with Dottie Foot and Martha Kemp.
