November 5, 2012

5:00 PM Deanna Carafelli She asked the selectmen if she could have the meeting (regarding the Buckmister property) upstairs instead of downstairs, also to have the fee waived. Richard Carver made a motion to waive the fee and let them use the upstairs, Nancy Colson seconded it.

5:03 PM Jeff Labrozzi told the selectmen that the floats have been brought in except the big one. They are going to leave it in and just move it during a storm. He brought in pictures of the floats. They need to be repaired. He is going to get estimates on much it is going to cost.
