

Selectman's Meeting

4:00 PM Tom Von Malder called the meeting to order.

Linda Post motioned to accept the minutes from February 6, 2017 as amended. Dave Matthews seconded. All in favor.

Tom Von Malder received a letter from MRC.

Dave Matthews explained to the Selectmen the Thomaston Group's (Owls Head, South Thomaston, and Thomaston) option of keeping their shares with PERC or selling out. Each town must have a town vote on which option they want to take before December 15, 2017.

Richard Carver reported he found the Standards of town easement roads from December 1998 Selectman's meeting and a copy of MMA Municipal Road Manual on Obstructions. The Selectmen want to meet with Bill Leppanen for further discussion. No action was taken.

Richard Carver reported Ship to Shore has been sold.

Richard informed the Selectmen the Harbor Committee met on February 14, 2017 with Prock Marine to discuss installation of a town dock.

Prock Marine will be submitting an estimate for installation and for dredging.

Richard was told of a possible grant for the development of the waterfront. Georges River Land Trust has agreed to help write the grant.

Warrants were reviewed and signed.

Dave Matthews motioned to adjourn. Linda Post seconded. All in favor.
