

Selectman's Meeting Monday, March 21, 2016

4:00 PM Assessors Meeting opened.

Dave Matthews motioned to approve an abatement on property map 011 lot 037 as presented by the Assessors Agent for Thomas Swinton. Tom Von Malder seconded. All in favor.

An abatement for Leroy Benner was presented to the Selectmen. Abatement was tabled.

Resumes for the Harbor Master were reviewed. Interviews will be set up with the applicants.

The Selectmen requested that the appropriate step be taken to proceed with the foreclosure of the property located at Map 016 Lot 072, contacting Fred Newcomb and/or the Sheriff's Department if necessary.

The Airport Public Advisory Committee vacancy was discussed. Dave Matthews will draft a letter for the Committee regarding the District 1 seat.

Beth Fisher, Kimberly Appleby, and Joanne Richards gave a presentation on the Mid Coast School of Technology regarding the building of a new school.

The Selectmen approved the Conservation Commission's request to set up a display for their upcoming Earth Day event at the April 4, 2016 Special Town Meeting.

Selectmen approved to have the Roadside Cleaning week for April 17 to 23, 2016 with Free Stump Dump Day on Saturday April 23, 2016.

Tom Christie, on behalf of the Historical Society, requested permission to have the electricity at the Grange Hall disconnected at the meter. The Selectmen had no objection with this request.

Tom also updated the Selectmen on the long term plans for the Grange Hall and steps that have been taken so far.

Selectmen were informed that the Planning Board approved the Floodplain at their Public Hearing held on March 16, 2016.

The Zoning Ordinance Committee approved the Cemetery Ordinance as written and passed them on the Selectmen for final approval.

Dave Matthews motioned to approve the Cemetery Ordinances as written. Tom Von Malder seconded. All in favor.

Dave Matthews gave an update on the Solid Waste Board.

Selectmen reviewed a letter from the Assessors Agent on the funding for the purchase of land located at Map 011 Lot 033. After a discussion, the Selectmen decided to perceive with motion made at the March 7, 2016 to use undesignated funds for the purchase.

Warrants and Payroll were reviewed and signed.

Tom Von Malder motioned to accept the minutes as amended from March 7, 2016. Dave Matthews seconded. All in favor.
