

Selectmen's Meeting  
Tuesday, April 18, 2017

4:00 PM Thomas Von Malder called the meeting to order.

Linda motioned to accept the minutes (04-03-17) as amended. Dave Matthews seconded it. All in favor.

Dave Matthews motioned to award the Salt Bid to Morton Salt in the amount of \$58.39 per ton, 400 tons is the amount we requested. Linda Post seconded it. All in favor.

Dave Matthews motioned to have the Sand Bid tabled until the next meeting when Jake Barbour (JBI) can present a bid and amount of yards needed for the upcoming season. Linda Post seconded it. All in favor.

Frank Ross (Fire Chief) had asked the Selectmen if he has the right to hire new employees or do the Selectmen hire them? The Selectmen said that the Fire Chief has the right to hire new employees. If any members of the Volunteer Fire Department have a concern with operations of the Fire Department, they can come to a Selectmen's meeting.

William Leppanen (Road Commissioner) received a call about putting up a 25 MPH speed limit sign on Ballyhac Road after the turn off to Birch Point State Park. The selectmen asked William Leppanen to see if there are any speed limit signs on the road. Dave Matthews motioned that this topic be tabled indefinitely. Linda Post seconded it. All in favor.

Richard Carver showed the Board of Selectmen a survey of the boundary lines for the Ship to Shore Lobster Co. showing them the wooden platform actually exists on town property. Dave Matthews asked the other Selectmen for permission to have Frederick Newcomb look at the easement agreement he drafted for the new owners of Ship to Shore. All in favor.

Jake Barbour (JBI) and Lewis Edwards were present to discuss the turn around on Coopers Beach Road and the damage made by the snowplow driver. Dave Matthews told Mr. Edwards the Selectmen have not had a chance to talk to Jake Barbour (JBI) yet and they would like to go visit the sight in question before they have any discussion on this matter.

Dave Matthews motioned to sign a three year mowing contract with a \$300.00 a year amount of contract increase to Terry Morang. Linda Post seconded it. All in favor.

Warrants were reviewed and signed.

Meeting adjourned at 5:30 PM. Dave Matthews motioned to adjourn. Linda Post seconded it. All in favor.
